at the earliest opportunity.

The person to be appointed should be very well established in the field of the professorship in research and teaching and be able to represent it across the board. The person should support the "Provenance Research" focus established in Bonn in cooperation with the W 3 "Alfried Krupp von Bohlen and Halbach Professorship for Modern and Contemporary Art History (19th-21st centuries) with a focus on provenance research/history of collecting ", especially in interdisciplinary cooperation with the "Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Professorship for Civil Law, Art and Cultural Property Protection Law" in the Faculty of Law and Political Science. The prerequisite is a degree in art history completed with a very good doctorate and teaching experience. Intensive participation in the BA and MA courses in art history and other courses in cooperation as well as in administrative and committee work are expected. Initiative and participation in the acquisition of research projects as well as the continuation and strengthening of networking in the subject of art history, especially with museums and research institutions, are also expected.

Junior professorships are filled for a period of three years; an extension for a further three years is possible if the evaluation is positive.

Formal requirements are defined by § 36 of the Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz Nordrhein-Westfalen).
