Lecturer in Human Geography

- Teaching courses in human geography, with a particular focus on digital geographies and quantitative methods, in German and English (at bachelor's and master's level), with a total teaching load of 8 SWS,
 - Supervising theses at bachelor's and master's level in German and English,
 - Carrying out administrative duties for the department, particularly relating to teaching and learning,
 - Developing and implementing research and externally-funded projects in the field of human geography, ideally on topics in the area of digital geography.

- Completed Doctorate in human geography,
 - Ideally a *Habilitation* or equivalent level as demonstrated by relevant publications,
 - In depth expertise in human geography research methods,
 - Proven skills in teaching quantitative methods,
 - Very good teaching skills and a very high level of commitment to teaching,
 - Very good knowledge of current research approaches and theories in human geography,
 - Experience in supervising bachelor's and master's theses,
 - Proven experience in academic administration,
 - Excellent German language skills (C2 level) and very good English language skills (C1 level),
 - Committed, flexible, reliable and with a strong team spirit.
