Interim Professor (W3) "Innovation and Management in Agribusiness"

to be appointed as soon as possible.

The interim professorship is based at the Institute for Food and Resource Economics (ILR).

We are looking for a person distinguished by internationally visible scientific contributions in the areas management of innovation processes and development of new business models, preferably with a focus on the bioeconomic value chains agriculture, forestry and food industry.

Experience in the acquisition and implementation of third-party funded projects is required. Individuals in an early career phase, or with experience outside the academic sector, who demonstrate sufficient achievements in research and can teach at professorial level, are also encouraged to apply. Teaching responsibilities are within the area Agribusiness Management in the bachelor and master programs offered by the faculty.

Formal requirements are regulated by § 39 Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen).
