



The Faculty of Catholic Theology at the University of Bonn invites applications for the position of a

**W3 professorate for the
Exegesis and Theology of the Old Testament**

to commence on **April 1, 2025**.

The faculty is seeking to appoint an exceptional researcher with the ability to make an innovative contribution of fundamental importance to the field of Old Testament studies. The successful candidate will hold a relevant doctorate in Catholic theology and a Habilitation or equivalent qualification. The position requires the ability to conduct both research and teaching across the full breadth of the subject area. The holder of the professorship will be responsible for organizing the compulsory courses of Hebrew language required by the various degree programs taught in the Faculty of Catholic Theology. Some of the teaching involved with the post is to be provided within the scope of the teaching degrees run as part of the cooperation agreement with the University of Cologne. The successful candidate will also be required to teach in English on the faculty's planned master's degree program of Comparative Theology.

The selected candidate will participate in the design and implementation of faculty and university-based research projects. In particular, they will be expected to engage actively with the research theme of “Ambiguities – Identities – Designs of Meaning” both within the faculty and the Transdisciplinary Research Areas of the University of Bonn. Desirable qualifications are experience in the acquisition of third-party funding and international research cooperation. Participation in academic administration will also be expected.

The successful candidate will be a priest in the Roman Catholic Church.

Conditions of employment are in accordance with § 36 HG NRW.

Applications from qualified candidates with a certified severe disability or equivalent status are especially welcome.
