## **W2-Professorship Medical Psychology**

is to be filled as soon as possible on a permanent basis.

The incumbent should represent the subject of Medical Psychology in teaching and research. The professorship includes the direction of the Division of Medical Psychology as well as a leading senior medical or psychological position in the Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy (Director: Prof. Alexandra Philipsen).

The applicant should have an international scientific background in translational stress or affect research of psychiatric disorders. Relevant publications as well as the acquisition of third-party funds are required. We expect a compelling concept for the translation of molecular findings or approaches from mathematical behavioral modeling (computational psychiatry) into the clinical care of psychiatric patients (e.g. in the form of a consultation hour for stress-related disorders).

■ The professorship is intended to strengthen the research focus on neurosciences in the long term. Furthermore, close collaboration with other focal points of the faculty (e.g. genetics and epidemiology or immunology) is relevant due to their significance for the pathogenesis of psychiatric disorders. Close cooperation with research institutions, such as the Institutes of Human Genetics, Molecular Psychiatry, the Cluster of Excellence Immunosensation, the DZNE (German Center for Neurodegenerative Diseases), as well as other university institutes, such as the Institute of Psychology, is therefore desirable. Innovative teaching concepts for medical psychology and sociology are expected.

Prerequisites for employment are a habilitation or equivalent academic achievements pursuant to Section 36 Higher Education Act NRW (Hochschulgesetz - HG NRW), experience in student teaching and accreditation as a specialist in psychiatry and psychotherapy and/or as a psychological psychotherapist or a verifiable equivalent academic status.
