CORONA PREVENTION MEASURES

- Medical face mask: in public transport and medical facilities (doctors' offices, hospitals)
- Social distancing (1.5 meters, 5 feet) and regular handwashing
- [Corona Warn App](#): prove vaccinations status, trace encounters with infected people
- 2G (+) / 3G
- [Rapid tests](#): sometimes free (i.e. if you show symptoms, visiting someone in hospital, living in same household as an infected person, ...); costs € 3 (if participating in indoor event, high-risk status in warn app); costs more if no exceptions or situations apply

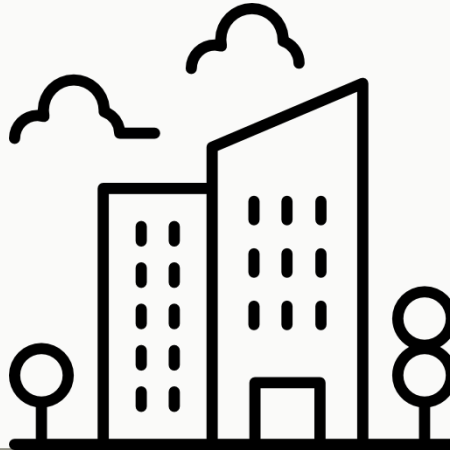

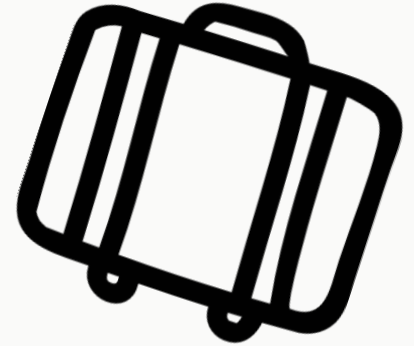

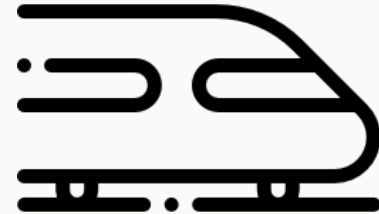
By plane:
