GERMAN COURSES AT THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

Intensive pre-semester courses

levels A1.1 to B2.2

16 hours per week for 3.5 weeks (56 hours total)

starting dates in September and March

Special topic courses

on various topics such as art, culture studies, business, academic vocabulary, presenting, intercultural skills etc.

levels A2 to C1

2 hours per week for 12 weeks

free of charge

Everyday language courses

levels A1.1 to B2.2

4 hours per week for 12 weeks

free of charge

Skills courses

phonetics, communicative grammar etc.

levels A2 to C1

2 hours per week for 12 weeks

free of charge
